Dear Knightdale UMC family & friends,

My favorite New Year's Eve memory from childhood involves my dad. He had an old sawed-off shotgun. When the fire siren went off at midnight, he would go in the front yard and shoot straight up in the air. Birdshot would fall for 50 yards on either side of us. I have often used that as an analogy for preaching. I am not aiming at specific persons, but if something in the sermon "hits" you, maybe God is speaking to you!

At our recent Charge Conference, the creation of a very part-time Associate Pastor position was approved. Starting January 15 Rev. Dede Pickle will assume that position. This is a very part-time position with only a small stipend. Rev. Pickle brings more than 20 years of experience in ministry to us. She will preach periodically, be available for pastoral ministry while the Senior Pastor is away, and also help out in other ways dependent upon her availability. Since retiring from active ministry, she has enjoyed being able to sit with her husband, Steve, in worship. I have encouraged her to not feel that she has to be on the platform every Sunday for every service. We are grateful for her willingness to serve among us and pray that our church will be a blessing to the Pickles, even as we anticipate they will be a blessing to us.

By now you have certainly noticed the new piano purchased just before Christmas, thanks to the generosity of a number of individuals and groups in our church. A new laser projector and electric screen for the sanctuary have also been ordered and shipped. One of my goals this year is to improve our sound system to be more dependable and functional! I have often said that having a church is like having a teenager: every time you turn around, there's an expense. But we are so blessed to be a part of a great church that is making a difference in our community and beyond for Jesus.

Be in prayer for our Sri Lanka Medical Mission Team January 16-25. The team of 8 includes 4 from KUMC: John Ward, Tom Maynard, Amber Thornton, and me. We will be staffing 2 mobile medical/eye clinics, distributing food and school supplies to poor families, and visiting a number of churches and ministry sites. We will represent the Kingdom of God and Knightdale UMC in a faraway place in keeping with Acts 1:8.

Best wishes to all in the new year. It will be exciting to see what all God has in store for us this year, as we strive to grow in faithful discipleship.
